- Elementary Grades 3-4 Girls

Born between April 2, 2015 and April 1, 2017

- Elementary Grades 5-6 Boys

Born between April 2, 2013 and April 1, 2015

- Elementary Grades 5-6 Girls

Born between April 2, 2013 and April 1, 2015

- Junior High Boys

Born between April 2, 2010 and April 1, 2013

- Junior High Girls

Born between April 2, 2010 and April 1, 2013

- Men, ages 18-39
- Women, ages 18-39
- Men, ages 40 and above
- Women, ages 40 and above

[Team Event (Épée, Foil, and Sabre - 1 fencer each, total 3 members)]

- Mixed gender, ages 18 and above

# [Sitting Foil (Priority to Para-Fencers)]

- Mixed gender, Junior High School and older

#### Notes:

- Over-age entries are allowed for one category above.
- High school fencers with about one year of experience may enter the "18-39" category.
- If entering both a regular and over-age category, priority will be given to your grade-level category; the other will be treated as "waitlist."

You will be notified later whether participation is possible.

- Depending on the number of applications, the 18+ categories may be combined.
- Team events are open to junior high and high school fencers with about one year of experience.

# 6. Equipment Requirements

- Uniforms and plastrons must be 350N or higher.
- Women must wear a hard chest protector (no need for soft pad cover).
- Masks: 350N acceptable; safety to be checked visually by referees.
- Velcro masks are also allowed.
- Gloves and cuffs may be separate types.
- For safety, 800N plastrons and gloves are recommended

# 7. Weapon Check

- No pre-check; referees will inspect weapons on the piste

- Equipment faults:

1st offense: Yellow card2nd and onward: Red card

#### 8. Match Format

Preliminary:

Pool format

Advancement rate to Direct Elimination to be announced later.

## Direct Elimination (Finals):

Individual Foil: 10-touch bouts (details to be announced later)

Team Event: Relay to 15 touches

No match for 3rd place.

#### Team Event Special Rules:

- Women's handicap:

If a male fencer fails to score 2 points, that bout counts as 0.

(This rule ensures fairness and fun for all participants.)

- Participants are asked to show consideration toward beginners.

# Sitting Event Rules:

- Handicaps will be set and announced later.

Open to all nationalities and places of residence

# 10.Entry Fee

- Individual event: JPY 5,000 per event
- Team event: JPY 13,000 per team
- Sitting foil: JPY 5,000 (JPY2,000 if also entering another category)

#### 11. How to Apply

Please complete your application via the designated online form by Monday, March 2, 2026.

## Team Event Entry

- Single or double entries are allowed.
- The tournament office will assign or match players to fill missing weapon categories.
- For single/double entries, apply by Saturday, February 21, 2026.
- Please note that team formation may not always be possible, and entry is not guaranteed. Apply with this understanding.
- Those applying for single or double entries should submit by **Saturday**, **February 21**, **2026**.

When applying, please provide your PayPal account information.

The entry fee will be billed to the specified PayPal account.

Entry fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.
